Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you for all your support so far this half term. Our students continue to work hard and demonstrate our school values, with visitors always commenting on the calm and purposeful atmosphere and friendly welcome from students and staff.

It has been great to see parents of students in Year 8 and 11 during our online subject Parents Evenings and Parent Forum, as well as in person at our wonderful winter concert, featuring over 100 of our students! We are very much looking forward to welcoming parents and family members who are attending or production of A Christmas Carol, with over 70 students taking part. We will be inviting parents of students in Year 8-11 to attend on site events to support their child's progress during the spring and summer terms.

Wednesday 14th December: Christmas Lunch: Next Wednesday we will be serving our annual Christmas lunch. This is for the usual meal price of £2.35 and provided for students in receipt of Free School Meals. The cost of the meal includes a traditional Christmas dinner with turkey or quorn roast, and a pudding of apple crumble or chocolate brownie. Please note that a drink is not included in the price but can be purchased separately, or students can refill their water bottle from our water coolers at no cost. There is no need to book. Lunchtime will be slightly extended for Year 7, 9 and 10. We hope the majority of students will have a festive meal on this day, but the pasta bar will also be open serving pasta pots, jacket potatoes and baguettes.

Monday 19th December: Nottingham Playhouse Remote Christmas Panto: On Monday afternoon Year 7 and 8 will be watching a recorded version of this year's Nottingham Playhouse Christmas Pantomime, Dick Whittington, which has been funded by our PTA. Groups in Year 9-11 will also be able to join in if they and their teacher would like to. We recognise that the cost of living increases will be impacting many families this year and hope that this will give our students the opportunity to enjoy a virtual trip to the panto together.

Tuesday 20th December: Last Day of Term: On this day school will close to students at the earlier time of 12.55pm for Year 7-8 and 1pm for Year 9-11. If you would like your child to be supervised in school until 3.10pm please contact the school office and we will arrange this. Students will attend their usual lessons period 1-2 and then have an end of term assembly and extended tutor period. Food will be available from the cafeteria during an extended breaktime.

This will be a non-uniform day to raise funds for Broxtowe Community Projects, one of the fantastic charities that support anyone in need in our community. Students may wear appropriate non-uniform in exchange for a £1 donation. Parents may pay on My Child at School or your child may bring cash on the day.

The donation is voluntary for students in receipt of Free School Meals – please be assured that this will be managed sensitively and confidentially on the day, and some other students will also not be paying on the day as parents will have paid in advance on MCAS.
